## FULL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Applicants to the Ffolio must be aged 18 or over on the commissioning date for applications to the round being applied for. They must be a UK resident and currently living in Wales.
2. Evidence of artistic merit, originality and feasibility will be the foremost consideration of the application panel along with the balance of ideas commissioned overall.
3. Not all shortlisted applicants will be selected for production, however they will still go through the professional development training stages.
4. Not all successful applicants who are commissioned to produce work will be transmitted or featured on BBC services.
5. These terms and conditions only govern your application to Ffolio. In the event that you are successful, you shall be required to enter into a licence agreement with the BBC, which will grant them the BBC Public Service Rights in the Content, including First Run/Exclusivity for 12 months from delivery date or 3 months after broadcast date, whichever is sooner.
6. Successful applicants will be expected to promote the project, be available for interviews and participate in events such as receptions, press activities and launches for Ffolio.
7. All shortlisted applicants must ensure that they are available for the filming and documenting of their work and for any related editorial activity.
8. Recipients of a Ffolio commission must acknowledge Arts Council Wales' support on every possible/relevant occasion including acknowledgment as principal funder of the final output/project and on any promotional material for your project.
9. With regards to data protection, Ffilm Cymru Wales will use each entrant's personal details for the purpose of administering this application.
10. The name, photograph and application of the successful applicants may be used by Ffilm Cymru Wales, BBC Wales and Arts Council Wales for publicity purposes. The selected filmmakers agree to Ffilm Cymru Wales, BBC Wales and Arts Council Wales using their name and likeness for advertising and publicity purposes in association with Ffolio without additional remuneration.
11. Any expenditure incurred or committed before a commission is granted is the responsibility of the successful applicant.
12. Selection of the winning projects remains the decision of the judges. The outcome of the judges' decision is final. There will be no recourse to appeal if applications have not been successful. Ffolio will provide feedback to unsuccessful shortlisted applicants.
13. Applicants must keep to the terms & conditions and not make any changes to the project without Ffilm Cymru Wales' and BBC Wales' advance written permission. If an applicant deliberately gives any false or misleading information, the applicant will be withdrawn or, if already awarded the commission, will be asked to pay back any money awarded.
14. Only one submission to each round of Ffolio is permissible.
15. If you have commercial representation then you must state this within your application.
16. The following are not eligible for Ffolio:
  - projects which will use the fund solely for the purchase of equipment;
  - projects which will have commenced filming or recording or been completed before the assessment of the application;
  - fundraising events;
  - activities for formal education purposes;
  - projects from creatives who have already directed a film or program which was funded and/or screened by a film or TV industry organisation.
